Delhi Jal Board is committed towards providing sustainable water distribution management to all parts of the Delhi city, continuing with these efforts, Sh. Kapil Mishra, Hon'ble Minister for Water and Chairperson, DJB inaugurated an Underground Reservoir and Booster Pumping Station of 38.6 ML Capacity at Dhichaun Kalan, Najafgarh today, on 19.01.2016.Sh. Kailash Gehlot, MLA, Najafgarh, Sh. R.S.Tyagi, Member (Water Supply) DJB and other officials of the Delhi Jal Board were also available on this occasion.

The work includes 2.50 Km feeder water line and 45 Km of distribution water lines. The total cost of this project is Rs. 64 Crores and it is expected to be completed in 18 months. The UGR will receive treated water from Nangloi Water Treatment Plant through 900mm dia water line from Nangloi Najafgarh Road.
